Tom Bowen had this innate intelligence, which guided him to understand the body with his hands. He used this gift to develop the procedures that would help the body to reset and rebalance itself.

The 'Hidden Pearls' are an attempt to explain some of the Bowen procedures with an anatomical view:.

The understanding of the body in the hands of the therapist necessarily passes through palpation of the body, with a clear picture in mind of what we are touching. Each move will be presented first with a power point presentation and then practiced with an emphasis on the palpation of the body.

We will also use tools like colour pencils to draw in the instruction manuals given to every student in each class.

Finally, videos on skin, muscles and fascia will complete the mental picture of inside of the body that a bodywork therapist needs to develop in order to feel better and work better.

Hidden Pearls 1

Part 1: not only will we see the musculoskeletal anatomy, but also the relation of the moves with the fascia, the nervous system and the lymphatic system.
